**ErasmusDays 2019 at Colegiul National Constantin Cantacuzino, Targoviste, Romania**

### **My Erasmus Experience-10 october 2019**

In October 2019, Colegiul National Constantin Cantacuzino from Targoviste- Romania joined the European event of ErasmusDays by organizing a round table with testimonials from Eurostronomia project.

Students and teachers who participated in a LTTA (at Wellington School in Ayr-Scotland-U.K., at Zavod Sv. Stanislava in Ljubljana-Slovenia) or in a TPM (at the Institut St. Dominique in Mortefontaine-France, at Colegiul National Constantin Cantacuzino in Targoviste-Romania and at SUGS Georgi Dimitrov in Skopje-Macedonia) shared their experience during learning-teaching-training-evaluation activities in order to raise the interest of the other colleagues in Erasmus+ projects and also to disseminate the results and the impact of the project to teachers and students' assembly in our school.

Through this interactive and dynamic presentation, Europe and its values reached our school. The participants in an Erasmus+ mobility presented to their colleagues, teachers and parents representants the experimental learning activities which increased their knowledge in astronomy, but also the socio-cultural experiences which enriched them at a personal level. They were very willing and confident to talk before such a large audience (60 persons) about the application of key-skills during the workshops: mathematical, scientific and digital skills, communication in English, entrepreneurial, problem-solving and social skills. Teachers shared the teaching methods and good practices used during the transnational meeting and talked about the additional eTwinning projects implemented.

The general impression was that the Erasmus+ programme through this Eurostronomia project is opening windows to pupils in all partner schools for higher education or even for future work anywhere in Europe, due to the multicultural environment and mixed working groups.
