### **The Lost City of Machu Picchu**

Hidden high in the Andes Mountains of Peru, Machu Picchu is one of the most remarkable archaeological sites in the world. Built by the Inca civilisation in the 15th century, the city remained unknown to the outside world for hundreds of years. Surrounded by steep cliffs and thick clouds, it was carefully placed to remain protected from enemies.

Although historians are not completely sure why Machu Picchu was built, many believe it served as a royal retreat or a sacred religious centre. Its remote location and impressive design continue to raise questions and attract researchers from around the globe.

The city is famous for its stone buildings, which were constructed without mortar. The stones fit together so perfectly that even today they cannot be separated with a knife. This advanced building technique helped the structures survive powerful earthquakes. Machu Picchu also includes agricultural terraces, temples and water channels. These features show the Incas' deep understanding of engineering and nature, allowing them to live in harmony with the mountainous environment.

After the fall of the Inca Empire, Machu Picchu was slowly abandoned and eventually forgotten. It was rediscovered in 1911 by the American explorer Hiram Bingham, who brought international attention to the site and its historical importance.
